(1) During the month of January, the Battalian was resupplied in the field with helicopters. Relicopter support was generally good. The biggest problem area existed in obtaining Class II and I' items to send to the field. Part of this problem was due to non-availability of certain Class II items at FIC and part to difficulty in transporting these items from Danang to 'n Hog. It is also felt that a Class IV dump should be established at the LAU in Now to aliminate the time lag involved in obtaining Class IV items to fly to the field.

WE STATE STATE AND LAND

During the month of January, Operation Taylor Common continued. The Bettelion continued its assigned mission of Rearch and Destroy. The commentes continued to patrol from commonly size petrol bases, making point contact numerous times with small units of 4-5 PTA/PC. Evenal but and bunker complexes were found and destroyed. Also a fairly large amount of enemy equipment and supplies were captured and/or destroyed.

As the Operation continues, it is evident that the large enemy force has departed from the area. However, one instance confirmed that the enemy was still canable of operating in this area in other than small size units. An estimated 20 MV4/VG did spring a well organized ambush on a Marine Combat Patrol resulting in moderate Marine casualties. Toint contacts did however remain the most common form of engagement.
